

2016 Rossi-Wallace Pinot Noir
Napa Valley

Pinot is such a friendly drink and our 2016 certainly falls into that category. Rich and seductive aromas of plum compote and ripe strawberry blend beautifully with a pleasant toasty oak background. All of these components are going to meld beautifully with just a bit more age. We love the flavors; warm and smooth – not a rough edge exists! This is just “so Pinot” and why it is so often the “go to” wine.

- Blend - 100% Atlas Peak Pinot Noir (Antinori Vineyard)
- Aged 30% new, 70% 1 year old Francois Ferrer Burgundy Barrels
- Left sur lees through August 22, 2017
- Bottled August 23, 2017 – 32 Barrels – 735 cases, 750ml produced
