2016 Rossi-Wallace Zinfandel Napa Valley

Let's face it ... it's both old California and Tuscan combined with its' racy-gamy aromas and flavors ... and a lot of fun to drink! This is what folks who love red wine like to put on the table often.

- Blend 80% Chiles Valley Zinfandel (Nichelini Vineyard)
 20% Atlas Peak Sangiovese (Antinori Vineyard)
- Aged one year in 1 year old Francois Ferrer Burgundy Barrels
- Left sur lees through August 22, 2017
- Bottled August 23, 2017 5 Barrels 122 cases, 750ml produced
